The new Regional Training Centre was opened on 14th May 2004. The new Dublin and East Leinster regional training centre for the Water Services National Training Group has been completed and opened by Fingal County Council.

The centre provides a training facility for the East Leinster Local Authorities Staff. The new centre is located at Ballycoolin and comprises 1300sq m of lecture rooms, an IT training room, meeting rooms, offices and workshop areas. The two storey building employs a fully networked IT system, audio visual equipment and air conditioning to ensure a modern comfortable and functional dedicated training facility.

Nicholas O'Dwyer were lead consultants for the project from the briefing through to practical completion. The training centre at Ballycoolen is part of a larger proposed complex comprising a water tower, reservoir and administration and stores building for which Nicholas O'Dwyer are also lead consultants.
