The project involved the construction of a two storey community centre, on site of the existing smaller centre, incorporating sports hall, clinic and ancillary accommodation.

Ancillary accommodation includes meeting rooms, nursery, changing facilities, clinic and canteen.

The structure consists of structural steel portal frame with precast concrete floors on load-bearing blockwork. The sports hall area provides for a full sized basketball court with optional retractable seating.

Generally, finishes within the building were painted fair-faced blockwork or plastered blockwork with an emphasis on robust design and longevity.
