Narrative Description of Project:

Supervision of the upgrade and rehabilitation of two sections of the M1 National Highway with a total length of 88km. Section 1 is Msasa Junction to Golomoti (M5) and is 30 km in length transversing a steep escarpment where the road drops about 800 m. Section 2 is Golomoti to the Monkey Bay Junction on the Mangochi road. This section is 58km in length crossing the flat floor of the Rift Valley.
