### Narrative Description of Project:

Tender Administration and construction supervision services for the upgrading and rehabilitation of 98km of the Northern Coastal Highway through coastal and urban terrain in Jamaica. Pavement consists of dual lane 7.3m wide carriageway with asphalt wearing course (100mm), crushed rock base course (150mm) and selected gravel sub-base (350-450mm). The works also include 110km of kerbs and gutters, 8 new bridges and 22 bridges rehabilitations, 173 new box culverts, 720 new pipe culverts, and 44km of new drinking water pipelines. Included ancillary works supervised were:

- Urban traffic lanes and traffic calming facilities.
- Non motorised traffic facilities (Pedestrian and Cyclist)
