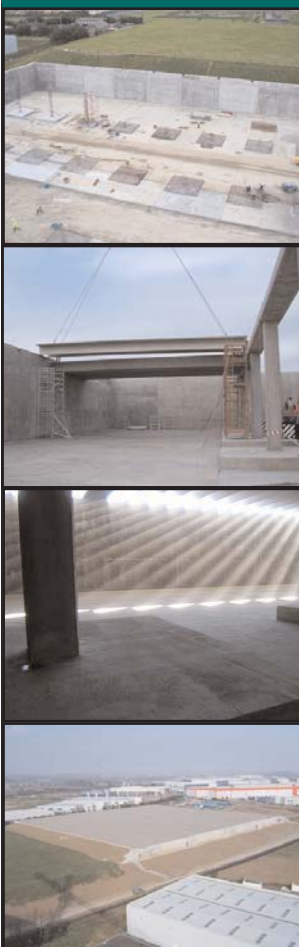

This project involved the construction of a 100,000m³ reservoir, 5,000m³ water tower, secondary chlorination plant and pumping station, administration and stores buildings, and water distribution infrastructure.

Phase 1 of the project comprised the construction of an additional 105,000m³ of Service Storage (100,000m³ Reservoir and 5,000m³ Water Tower), a new plant building to accommodate the new Secondary Chlorination Plant (OSEC) and a new Pumping Plant installation and a new Administration building and workshop. This construction commenced in March 2005.
